<i>The 2014 is characterised by perfumed fruit, a hint of baked apple, crisp mineral acidity and a soft, rounded texture provided by subtle use of oak.</i>

<i>Bright purple colour with magenta hues. Aromas of juicy black berries with a suggestion of vanilla. Beautifully balanced with delicate plum flavours and an elegant finish.</i>

<i>Smooth and elegant with a nose of crushed berries, blackcurrant and cherry. Aged in barrel for 12 months, there are also hints of leather, vanilla and cedar. Mellow and soft on the palate with a great finish.</i>

<i>What we love about this Reserva is that although it has those classic Rioja notes of tobacco, leather and spice, its relative youth means that it also has an abundance of pure, fresh fruits.</i>			
<b>Corbieres, l'Entete, Jeff Carrel, France 2011</b>			<b>29.00</b>
<i>Another great wine from the Carrel Winery, medium bodied, fruity, dry and vibrant.</i>			
<b>Marques de Solariego, Rioja Gran Reserva, Spain, 2007</b>			<b>35.00</b>
<i>2007 was an outstanding Rioja vintage and this sublime ten-year-old Gran Reserva, aged in barrel for three years is now drinking at its peak. With superlative elegance and finesse and layers of smooth berry fruits, tobacco, leather and spice, reserve this for special occasions.</i>			
<b>Joseph Voillot Bourgogne, Pinot Noir, France 2012</b>			<b>40.00</b>
<i>Sourced from vineyards stretching from Volnay up to Nuits-Saint-Georges. There is good concentration this year owing to the lower yields, as well as a lovely purity of fruit. Delicious, juicy, red berry fruits are complemented by delicate spice and an attractive, fresh finish.</i>
